Safeguarding Advice for Parents & Carers of Child Bowlers (U18)

Everyone has the right to have fun and be safe and free from harm when participating in sport and physical activity. Parents or carers should be able to check how well a bowls club is run, for the sake of their child's safety and their peace of mind. Bowls clubs have responsibilities to ensure that their coaches and other staff are safe to work with children. Clubs should be able to provide confirmation that staff and volunteers are suitable and have undergone the right checks. All organisations providing sports for children should welcome questions about how they will keep children safe. Parents/carers should ask to see:

- The club Safeguarding Policy
- The name and contact details of their Safeguarding Officer (may be called a Welfare Officer)
- The Code of Conduct for members does this include sections for parents/carers and U18 bowlers?
- Consent forms for Parents/Carers regarding filming / photography, travel, medical issues
- Emergency contact form for them to complete
- Expectations regarding supervision of U18s
- Drop-off and collection arrangements (if not needed for supervision)
